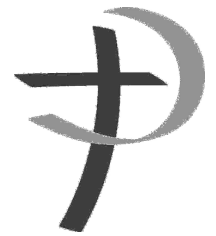

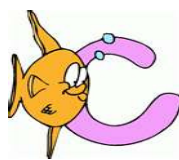

until we begin to use the ordinary of the new translation of Mass.

It is a chance to remind ourselves about how we receive the Eucharist. The Church allows that those who receive Holy Communion may do so *standing or kneeling, on the tongue or in the hands*. When receiving on the hands they should be clean, free of gloves and made into a throne. The host should be placed in the mouth with the lower hand. The practise of *intinction* (dunking the host into the precious blood) by the communicant himself is *forbidden* by the Bishop's Conference. This is because Holy Communion is *given* and is not self-service. When standing for Holy Communion, the communicant should bow when approaching the Sacred Host.

Singing is an important aid to liturgy and we shall be using adapted as well as new music for the Ordinary. For the first few weeks we shall say the Gloria & the Eucharistic Acclamation until we get used to the new words.

We shall need to follow the cards closely. Although you may, if you wish, still follow the readings in missals you will **not** find other parts of the Mass in them, so please do not try.
