Chrism Mass



is on Wednesday 17th April at 12noon in the Cathedral and all are welcome to this celebration. The Chrism Mass, which the bishop concelebrates with his presbyterium (priests of the diocese), and at which the oils are blessed, manifests the unity and communion of the priests with their bishop as both he and they renew their ordination vows. The oil of the Chrism is consecrated for use in Baptism, Confirmation, Ordinations and the consecration of altars and churches. The Oil of Catechumens is blessed and used in the anointing of those preparing for baptism. The Oil of the Sick is used in anointing those facing illness, surgery or in danger of death.

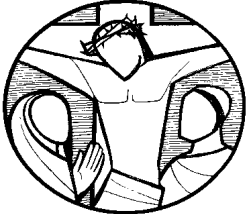


There is a list in the porch at St Mary's for volunteers to take part in the washing of feet by *Fr Ciaran*, seats will
